FEES AND CHARGES REGULATION

PART 1 - PRELIMINARY

1 Short Title

This regulation may be cited as the Fees and Charges Regulation.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 August 2009.

3 Purpose of Regulation

The purpose of this regulation is to:

- (a) establish the prescribed fees and charges for the operation of the association, including but not limited to membership fees and alpaca registration fees, and
- (b) establish all other matters incidental and relevant to regulation 3 (a).

4 Definitions

In this regulation:

"Director-General" means the Director-General of the Department of Fair Trading.

"the Act" means the *Associations Incorporation Act 1984*.

"association" means AABA.

"AABA" means the Australasian Alpaca Breeders Association, Inc.

"GST" means Goods and Services Tax.

"AAR" means Australasian Alpaca Register.

5 Notes

Any explanatory notes and tables of contents do not form part of this Regulation.

PART 2 - FEES

6 Annual Membership Subscription

- (1) The annual membership subscription is payable for the year ending 30 June.
- (2) The amount payable is detailed in Schedule 1.

7 Other Fees and Charges

Other fees and charges payable from time to time are detailed in Schedule 1.

8 Goods and Services Tax

- (1) AABA is registered for GST.
- (2) Fees quoted in Schedule 1 include GST.

SCHEDULE 1 - FEES AND CHARGES

Amounts quoted are in Australian dollars inclusive of GST.

Overseas residents do not pay Goods and Services Tax (GST) in which case deduct one eleventh. For example, Joining Fee would be \$AU20.00 not \$AU22.00
